

HOUSING INVENTORY COUNT GUIDE



WHAT IS THE HOUSING INVENTORY COUNT (HIC)?

An inventory of a community's homeless assistance project beds and units on a single night. The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Continuums of Care (CoCs) conduct one HIC annually, which occurs on the same day as the Point-in-Time Count (PIT) in January. SARA, the San Antonio and Bexar County CoC, conducts four additional HICS on a quarterly basis.

WHY CONDUCT QUARTERLY COUNTS?



Receive quarterly reports on bed utilization



Improved Homelink referral process



Assist project housing utilization
