Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Updates

NEW ESG-CV Notice CPD 22-06 (Released April 2022)

- **Updated expenditure deadlines –**
 - In the initial notice there was a requirement to have 80% funds expended by March 31, 2022 and the final expenditure deadline was September 30, 2022
 - The **new expenditure deadline** is : 50% expenditures must be drawn by **June 16, 2022**, and the final expenditure deadline for CV 1 and CV2 is extended until **September 30, 2023**.
 - This waiver does not apply to other funding sources and has **not** been extended for CoC, YHDP, and HOPWA.

Housing Bond

NEW Housing Bond Proposition F Approved

- **\$150 million awarded for affordable housing**
 - Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) is listed as one of the top five funding priority categories and will have \$25 million dedicated to supporting the housing gap in our community.
 - This funding will be able to support 250 PSH households but when leveraged with other dollars it could be up to 500 PSH households.

Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA)

- **NEW 2022 HUD ESG and ESG-CV income limits**
 - You can find this new income limit guidance at TDHCA under [Tools and Guides /Client Eligibility](#)
- ESG **Annual** Subrecipients must use the 2022 30% Area Median Income Limits as of April 18, 2022.
- ESG-CV **CARES** subrecipients must use the 2022 30% Area Median Income Limits and 50% Area Median Income as of April 18, 2022.
