Overview

- This HUD NOFO is a first-of-its-kind funding opportunity to fund projects through the CoC Program outside of the traditional CoC NOFO process.
- This "Special NOFO" is a competitive grant application to address unsheltered homelessness
- The application is similar to the regular CoC NOFO in that only SARA as the Collaborative Applicant can apply on behalf of the community.
- Projects are funded for a 3-year grant and will be rolled into the regular CoC Program thereafter. If selected San Antonio/Bexar County can receive up to \$14,572,376.

Overview

- HUD priorities include the following:
 - Unsheltered Homelessness
 - Housing First
 - Health and Housing partnerships
 - Stability Vouchers (SV)
 - Advancing Equity
- Each community must develop a plan for utilizing these funds.

- **Technical Assistance Sessions:** September 6-14, 2022
- **Application Deadline:** September 20, 2022, at 11:59 pm
- **Notification Provided to Applicants:** October 5, 2022
- **Consolidated Application Due to HUD, Submitted by SARA:** October 20, 2022
