



## 2018 NOFA CoC Program Grant Competition

### **ATTENTION: CoC & Potential CoC Program Competition Applicants!**

Earlier in June, [HUD announced](#) that the [Notice of Funding Availability \(NOFA\) for the Fiscal Year \(FY\) 2018 Continuum of Care \(CoC\) Program Competition](#) was posted to the [FY 2018 CoC Program Competition: Funding Availability](#) page on the HUD Exchange. ### **Funding Available for New Projects:**

#### **Bonus funding:**

**Amount:** \$659,120

*How much of this bonus is obtained will be determined by the score of the CoC application and how bonus projects are ranked in the competition.*

#### **Domestic Violence Bonus:**

**Amount:** \$1,098,533

*DV bonus funds will be awarded based on the CoC score, need for the project, and capacity of the proposed provider of DV services.*

#### **Reallocation funds:**

**Amount:** \$842,000

*Additional new projects may be created using reallocated funding*

### **Application Deadlines:**

**Renewal Applications | Monday, July 30th | 5:00 PM**

**New Applications | Friday, August 3rd | 8:00 PM**

### **Eligible project types:**

#### **New project categories:**

CoCs may create up to one of each of the following project types:

- Permanent Housing-Rapid Rehousing (PH-RRH);
- Joint Transitional Housing (TH) and Permanent Housing-Rapid Rehousing (PH-RRH) component project; and
- Supportive Services Only-Coordinated Entry (SSO-CE).

**Renewals:**

Any organization with a CoC funded grant that is expiring in calendar year 2019 may submit a renewal application.

**Consolidated Project - \*NEW\*:**

Eligible renewal project applicants will have the ability to consolidate two or more (limit of four) eligible renewal projects into one project application during the application process.

**Transition Application - \*NEW\*:**

The transition application will be available to existing projects. The concept is that projects wishing to transition to a new project type will begin the program year as one project type (e.g. TH) and transition throughout the year into a new, eligible project type (PSH, PH-RRH, SSO).
